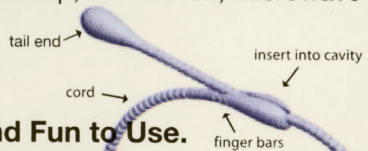


The first heat resistant silicone food trussing* tool designed to replace kitchen string and toothpicks in the prep and cooking process.

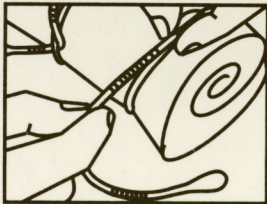
- heat-resistant to 675°F

 - Use **thefoodloop**[®] in any pan on the stove top, in the oven, microwave or in the freezer.



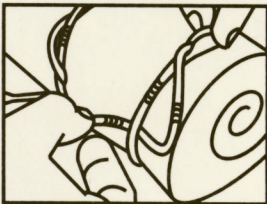
thefoodloop[®] — Quick, Easy and Fun to Use.

- Snap the segmented cord into the cavity end to form a loop.
- Place **thefoodloop**[®] around food, grasp finger bars on cavity sides, with the other hand grab the tail end and cinch tight. Tuck the tail under cord. For larger foods, such as a roast, snap several loops together.
- Cook food as needed. **Caution:** loops become HOT during cooking.
- To remove **thefoodloop**[®], let cool, then pull up the tail end to disconnect.
- To clean **thefoodloop**[®], place in the dishwasher in the provided mesh bag, or hand wash. Then store in the bag for your next trussing event.

How to Use:
1. Place **thefoodloop**[®] around food and cinch to hold.

2. Tuck the tail end under the cord for added grip and ease of handling.
