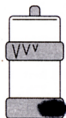


Filling Instructions



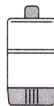
Standard Chef's Mill

- Unscrew top knob. Lift and remove lid.
- Pour peppercorns into bottom container and reassemble.



Combination Mills

- Unscrew top knob. Lift and remove lid.
- Lift and remove salt container. Refill with table salt.
- Pour peppercorns into bottom container and reassemble.



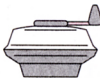
Genie Combo - Genie Combination Mills

- Unscrew top knob. Lift and remove lid.
- Lift and remove salt container. Refill with table salt.
- After removal of salt container, turn pepper container upside down.
- Lift chrome base and turn 90°. Fill with peppercorns.
- Lift and rotate to return base to original position. Reassemble.



Mills with Crank Handles

- Unscrew top knob. Lift and remove lid and handle assembly.
- Pour peppercorns into bottom container and reassemble.



Nut Twister - Nutmeg Mill

- Hold mill upside down. To open, rotate base counter clockwise.
- Center nutmegs on prongs, as shown.
- Replace base by compressing spring, and twist clockwise to lock in place.



Genie Mills

- Turn mill upside down.
- Lift chrome base and turn 90°. Fill with peppercorns.
- Lift and rotate to return base to original position. Reassemble.

Use & Care Tips

When refilling the salt chamber in a combination mill, be sure to clean the stem. Salt is very corrosive, and a build-up of salt can be detrimental to your mill. Applying a drop of cooking oil on the threads, at the top of the stem where the top nut is screwed on, is also recommended.

Adjusting Milling Mechanism

Mills with adjusting rings:

Grip the ring and twist it clockwise, locking it into a position, to increase the size of the crushed pepper, and counter-clockwise to decrease the size. There are three adjustments - fine, medium and coarse.

Mills without adjusting rings:

Turn the top screw clockwise to increase the size of the crushed pepper, and counter-clockwise to decrease the size.

Mills with adjustment dial on bottom:

Turn dial on the bottom of the mill, line up arrow toward the smallest dot for fine mill & toward larger dot for coarse.
